The Town Council of the Town of Liberty, Indiana had a special meeting on November 25, 2024 in the Union County Commissioners' Chambers of the Union County Courthouse.

ROLL CALL

MISC. BUSINESS

President Bias thanked the members for attending the special meeting he called. Mr. Bias believe it was imperative to call the special meeting to review Frontier Communications' request to install fiber optic cabling to the new Indiana Bureau of Motor Vehicles suite on Independence Lane. Mr. Bias did not want to hold up the BMV opening until after the December 2nd meeting. The contractor was ready to install the morning of the 25th. At the November 18, 2024 meeting, Mr. Reuss and members of the Council were concerned on the placement of the fiber optic line in conjunction with the force main and the other utilities. The Tuesday after the meeting, Frontier's engineer reached out to Mr. Reuss to discuss the placement. Mr. Reuss informed the engineer of the Town's concerns and had the plan re-drawn to Mr. Reuss's request. The Council members reviewed the new submittals with Mr. Reuss. After a brief discussion, Mr. Keasling made a motion to approve the fiber optic installation per the new drawings. Mr. Jenkins supported the motion. Upon a vote viva voce, motion passed.
