PROCEEDINGS OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF LIBERTY, INDIANA ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION HEARING October 7, 2024

The Town Council of the Town of Liberty, Indiana met for an additional appropriation hearing on October 7, 2024 in the hallway in front of the Union County Commissioner's Chambers due to the room being locked for early voting.

Town Council President Keith Bias called the meeting to order.

ROLL CALL

Present were: Ross Keasling, Derrek Jenkins, Dereck Tipton and Jerry Kahl.

Also in attendance was Melissa Shepler, Clerk-Treasurer; Matt Reuss, Todd Dickenson and Jim Barnhizer.

HEARING

Mr. Bias asked Ms. Shepler to review the additional appropriation request with the Council. Ms. Shepler stated that the additional appropriation for the Edit fund is a corrective action due to the 2024 Budget Ordinance not matching the appropriations in the accounting software. She explained that when she entered the 2024 budget in Gateway, to formulate the ordinance, the Special Projects Coordinator and the Promotion of Town Funds that goes to the Historical Society did not get entered or saved after it was entered even though she had put it in Keystone. This action is to make sure that the appropriations match as well as the Historical Society has received their funds and the money set aside for the Special Projects Coordinator, which the position has not been filled, has been transferred to a capital asset appropriation to pay for the tank that will be installed for the administration building generator.

The additional appropriation is \$20,000.00 for the Special Projects Coordinator and \$2,500.00 for the Promotion of Town Funds that are paid out of the Edit Fund.

Mr. Bias then asked for public participation.

None occurred.
